On-Site Medical:

On-Site non-emergency medical needs for scrapes and bruises will be attended by nurses from Alexian Brothers Medical Center. There will be a medical tent located behind the Start/Finish Stage in the skate park parking lot for the races occurring in Elk Grove located on Elk Grove Boulevard between Ridge and Victoria Streets.

Stationed on the course near the emergency command post will be an ALS medical ambulance with paramedics for quick reaction to any medical calls.

Race Caravan Medical Support:

For immediate response an ambulance is centrally located with the Schaumburg course to provide aid to injured riders during the Men's Pro Road Stage while the race is in the Village of Schaumburg.

Alexian Brothers Hospital Medical Staff –

Medical staff will be provided by the Alexian Brother Medical center and a first aide tent will be located adjacent to the start/finish of the Elk Grove portion located at 220 Elk Grove Boulevard.

- For emergencies, please dial 911 on your cellular phones or use a radio if available (all race chatter is monitored by police dispatcher). All emergency situations will follow the emergency medical response protocols set forth by the Village of Schaumburg and the Village of Elk Grove.

Anti-doping

The Tour of Elk Grove will have anti-doping control per the regulations of USA Cycling.

Any USA Cycling member could be tested at any event and must adhere to all USADA anti-doping control procedures.

Communications

Race Communications

Radio Communications equipment will be provided to staff, officials and select event staff in the form of hand-held radios. These radios will be used for separate functions with channels for:

- Officials
- Race Caravan
- Radio - Tour
- Media Operations
- Event Staff
- Registration
- Police
- Fire Department

Teams will be provided a radio with multiple channel outputs for use during the road stage. Radio frequencies for the above groups take priority over cycling team's communications and teams cannot interfere with these frequencies while participating.

Special Events Management reserves the right not to issue a radio to any person not adhering to the above procedures and requesting teams to eliminate their communications if such frequencies interfere with the priority frequencies used for the race.

Transmitting Priorities

- Immediate threat to life or safety of person(s)
- Possible hazards to life, safety, or property
- Race critical information or decisions (especially officials' decisions)
- Urgent, time critical transmissions
- All other communications

Media

Media Information

The event organizers, the Village of Elk Grove and Village of Schaumburg respectfully ask that in all instances the event be referred to by its full name, the “Alexian Brothers Tour of Elk Grove”.

Interviews & Official Spokespersons

Each professional cycling team or individual cyclist in the race and each sponsor will have access to the official spokespersons and contact information for the Alexian Brothers Tour of Elk Grove. Only these representatives may serve as official spokespeople.

The press team encourages each cycling team and or cyclist to be open to granting interviews with the media at a convenient time. The press representatives can assist in arranging interviews with cyclists and teams during the race, if time permits. However, the press representative encourages media contact directly with each team’s press officer prior to the race to schedule onsite interviews prior to race day or for a convenient time on-site during the race.

Television Interviews

Team directors and press officers are encouraged to consider the value of television interviews, and accommodate all possible opportunities.

The press representatives request that athletes be prepared for television interviews to take place immediately following each race and prior to the awards ceremonies so that the event may run as scheduled.

Photographers

All photographers hired by teams must also wear a media credentials, and in some instances an official vest, to avoid confusion and in order to be allowed in media specific areas. Approved photo credentials may be picked up in the Media Check in area located just behind the start/finish announcer stand at Audubon Park on Elk Grove Blvd. between Victoria and Ridge Streets.

Press Opportunities

It is expected that the top three finishers, the race stage leader, and overall points leader report to the awards podium immediately after each race to be presented with awards, possible sponsor and media photo opportunities.

KEY MEETINGS AND EVENTS

Friday, August 1, 2008

Race Registration is located in Hattendorf Center Gymnasium at 225 Elk Grove Blvd. Registration will be open from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm. A team managers meeting will be held at 10:00 am at Village Hall in the Council Chambers located at 901 Wellington. Team managers or riders will pick up the rider bib numbers during the hours designated for registration and pickup. After 2:00 p.m. no professional riders competing in the three stages will be accepted for registration.

Saturday, August 2, 2008

The race registration will be located at the Hattendorf Center gymnasium at 225 Elk Grove Blvd. Registration will be open from 7:00 am to 3:00 pm for category and amateur riders only. Team managers of Cat 1,2 teams or other category riders will pick up rider bib numbers during the hours designated for registration and pickup.

Sunday, August 3, 2008

The race registration will be located at the Hattendorf Center gymnasium at 225 Elk Grove Blvd. Registration will be open from 7:00 am to 1:00 pm for category and amateur rider's only and riders will pick up rider bib numbers during the hours designated for registration and pickup only.

RACE REGULATIONS

Article 1. Organization

The Alexian Brothers Tour of Elk Grove is organized by Chicago Special Events Management in conjunction with the Village of Elk Grove and Village of Schaumburg under the regulations of USA Cycling (USAC). It is to be held from August 1-3, 2008.

Article 2. Governing Rules

Unless specifically addressed within these articles, all race regulations for the Alexian Brothers Tour of Elk Grove will be governed by the 2008 USA Cycling (USAC) Rules for Road, Track, and Cyclocross.

Article 3. Type of Event

Alexian Brothers Tour of Elk Grove will provide a variety of events for competitive cyclists over the three day event. These cycling events are:

- Pro Men's three-stage Race
 - a. Time-Trial
 - b. Road Stage
 - c. Criterium
- Elite 1/2 two-stage race
- Elite 3/4
- Men's Cat 5
- Women's Pro, 1, 2
- Women's Cat 3,4
- Master's Cat 1,2
- Master's Cat 3,4
- Master's Cat 5

Article 3a. Participation

The event is open to only the following:

- UCI Continental Pro teams
- UCI Continental teams
- National teams
- Pro individuals

Competition is by teams and individuals. For the Pro team competition teams shall be composed of a maximum of 6 riders to a minimum of 4

Directions

FROM THE NORTH:

- Take Interstate 90 West to Route 53 South. Stay on Route 53 as it merges into I-290 East in the vicinity of Woodfield Mall.
- Take I-290 East to Thorndale Ave. Exit at Thorndale, follow ramp to the right and head west. Thorndale will become the Elgin-O'Hare Expressway. Take the Elgin-O'Hare Expressway 4 miles west to the Springinsguth - Irving Park Road Exit. Exit and turn left at the second light (Springinsguth).
- Drive under the expressway overpass. Alexian Field is just on the other side on the left. Parking is accessible on the right-hand side.
- From I-294: Take I-294 to I-90 West.

FROM THE SOUTH:

- Take Interstate 90 West to Route 53 South. Stay on Route 53 as it merges into I-290 East in the vicinity of Woodfield Mall.
- Take I-290 West to Thorndale Ave. Turn left at the light and head west. Thorndale will become the Elgin-O'Hare Expressway. Take the Elgin-O'Hare Expressway 4 miles west to the Springinsguth - Irving Park Road Exit. Exit and turn left at the second light (Springinsguth).
- Drive under the expressway overpass. Alexian Field is just on the other side on the left. Parking is accessible on the right-hand side.

FROM THE WEST:

Take U.S. Highway 20 (Lake Street) to the Elgin-O'Hare Expressway. Join the Elgin-O'Hare Expressway and head east to the Springinsguth Road Exit. Exit and proceed directly to Alexian Field. - The stadium will be on your left with parking on the right.

FROM SCHAUMBURG:

Take Roselle Road south to the Elgin-O'Hare Expressway. Take the Elgin-O'Hare Expressway west to the Springinsguth - Irving Park Road Exit. Exit and turn left at the second light (Springinsguth).

Drive under the expressway overpass. Alexian Field is just on the other side on the left. Parking is accessible on the right-hand side.

Team representatives or individual riders are requested to confirm their registration and collect their race numbers at race headquarters beginning one hour before the start of their race.

The team managers meeting will be organized in accordance with USA Cycling regulation 4F3, in the presence of the Members of Commissaries Panel. See Key Meetings and Events for more information on the team managers meeting

Article 5. Race Number Placement

Time Trial: Race number placement for the time trial shall be one number placed on the right side of the jersey (Criterium style) or center of back.

Road Race: Each participant will use all race numbers provided. One prominently displayed on the right side (Criterium style) and one appearing on the participant's left jersey pocket and the numbers are vertical (European style). Frame numbers should be displayed either behind the head tube or behind the seat.

Criterium: Each participant will use all race numbers provided. One prominently displayed on each side of the body (typical Criterium fashion). Frame numbers should be displayed either behind the head tube or behind the seat.

Article 6. Team Cars

No team cars will be allowed on the road course while in Schaumburg. Vehicles must be staged in a neutral area within the course. All athletes will have assistance by the neutral support vehicle and at a time when the field transitions from the road course in Schaumburg from Weathersfield Way onto Plum Grove Road will team cars will then be allowed to support their teams. Once entering Elk Grove Village, the team cars will again be designated to neutral areas.

Section 2

Technical Guide

STAGE 1 – At 5:30 P.M. FRIDAY AUGUST 1st

RIDER SIGN-IN / STAGING

Time Trial Start List - The top 10 finishers from 2007 will be placed in reverse order at the end of the time trial field with last year's winner being the last racer slotted. The remaining start list will be determined by a random drawing. The Chief Referee will adjust the start order to prevent teammates from starting in succession.

TIME TRIAL START LOCATION

Located at the corner of Ridge and Elk Grove Boulevard approximately 100 meters west of the main stage start/finish location.

TIME TRIAL LOGISTICS

All athletes will line up according to their assigned times on Ridge Street north of Elk Grove Boulevard. Announcements will be continually broadcasted informing the next ten riders that they are about to begin. An electronic start list will be posted on a plasma screen near the time trial starting ramp. The ramp will be elevated 12" high. All riders must present themselves for checks on their bicycles no later than 15 minutes before their start time and are ultimately responsible to be in position to start the time trial at their designated time.

Riders will start in 60 second intervals. Any rider finishing in a time exceeding that of the winner by more than 5% shall not be placed. The time limit may, in exceptional circumstances be increased by the Commissaire panel in agreement with the organizer. The order of finish will determine caravan order.

TIME TRIAL COURSE DESCRIPTION

The course is 4.5 miles (7242 meters) with five turns, and a long straight away to the finish line. The course is on residential and business streets of Elk Grove Village. Please be aware and courteous of public and private property. Public urination will not be tolerated at this event. Port-a-Pots will be located at the neutral support area located at Love and Elk Grove Boulevard and near the start/finish area located at both Audubon Park (behind the announcers trailer) and in the Hattendorf Center (located behind the corporate VIP area) The start and finish line is located adjacent to the Hattendorf Center parking lot (225 Elk Grove Blvd.).

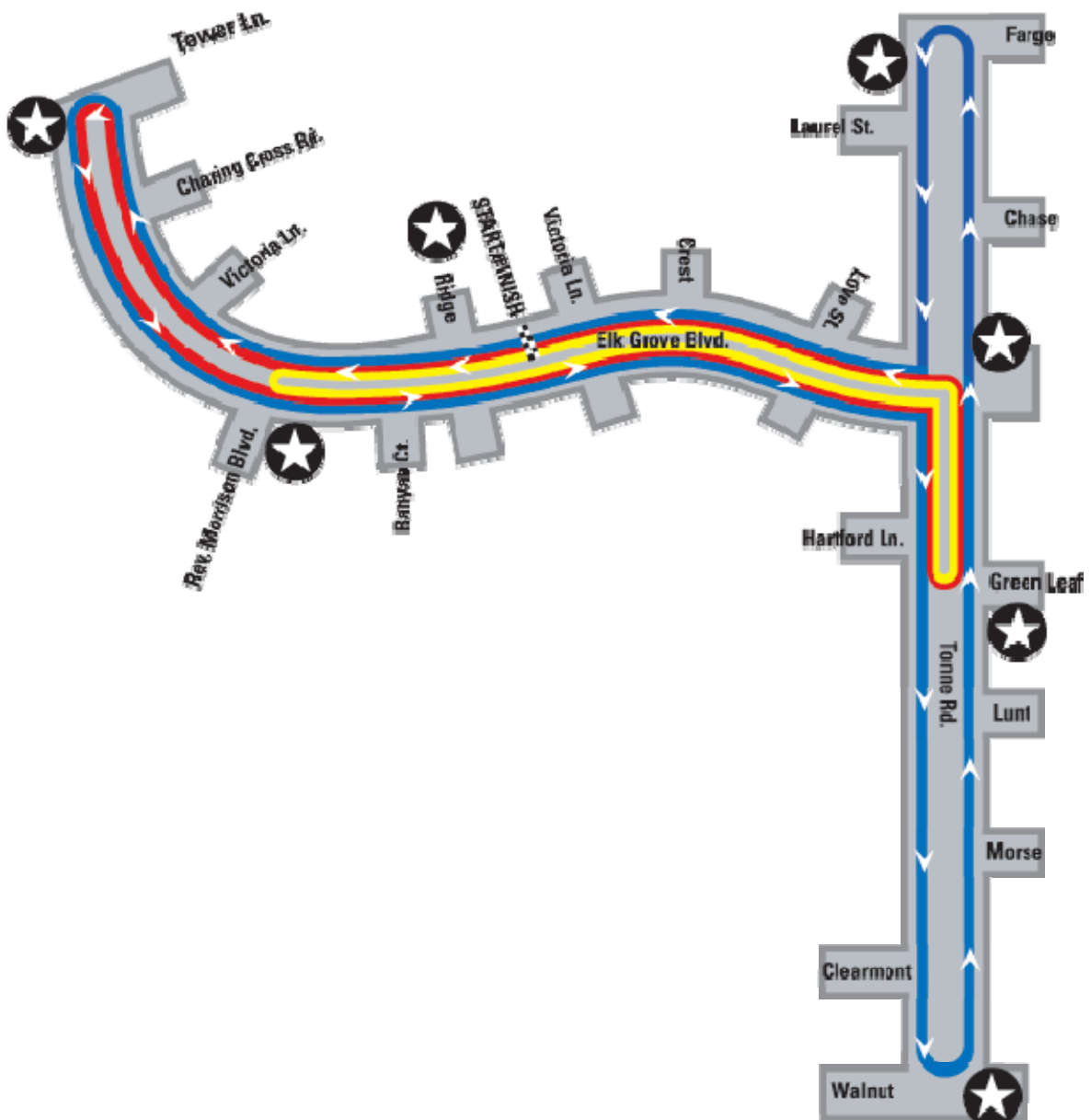


Friday Elk Grove Village Bank & Trust Stage 1 Time-Trial

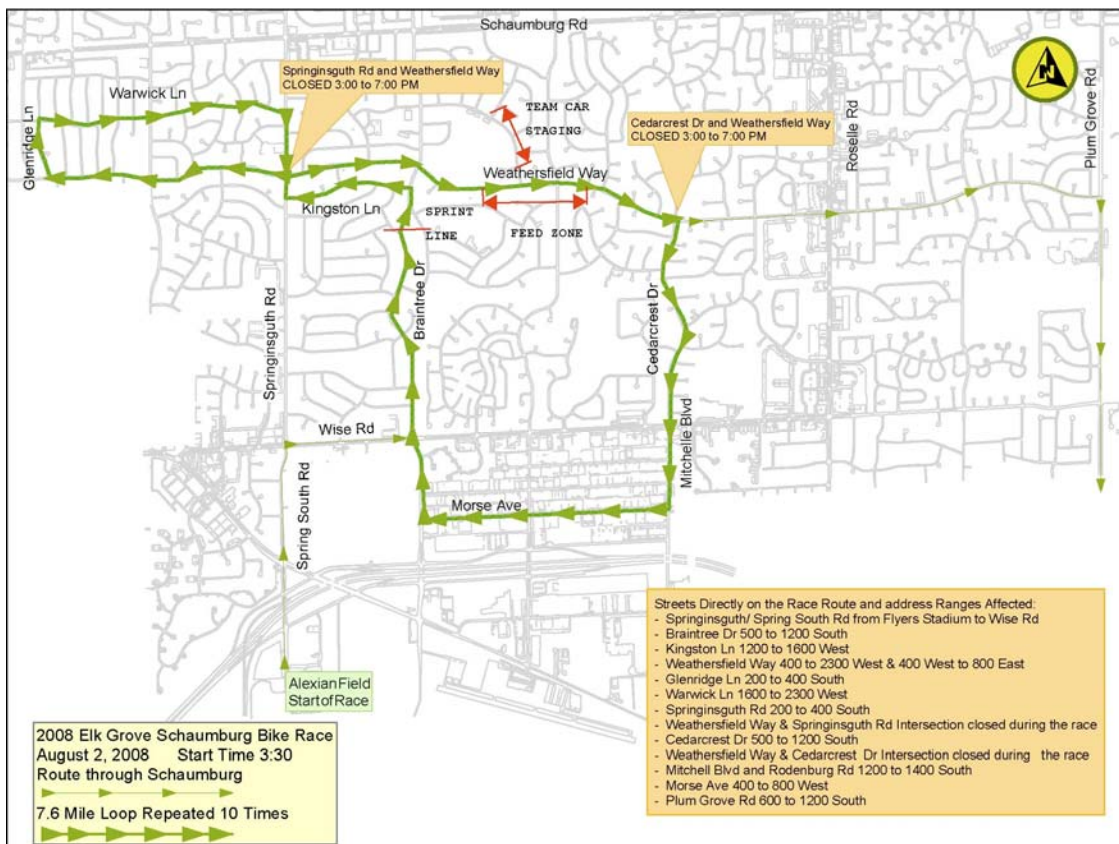
STAGE 2 – AT 3:30 P.M. SATURDAY, AUGUST 2nd

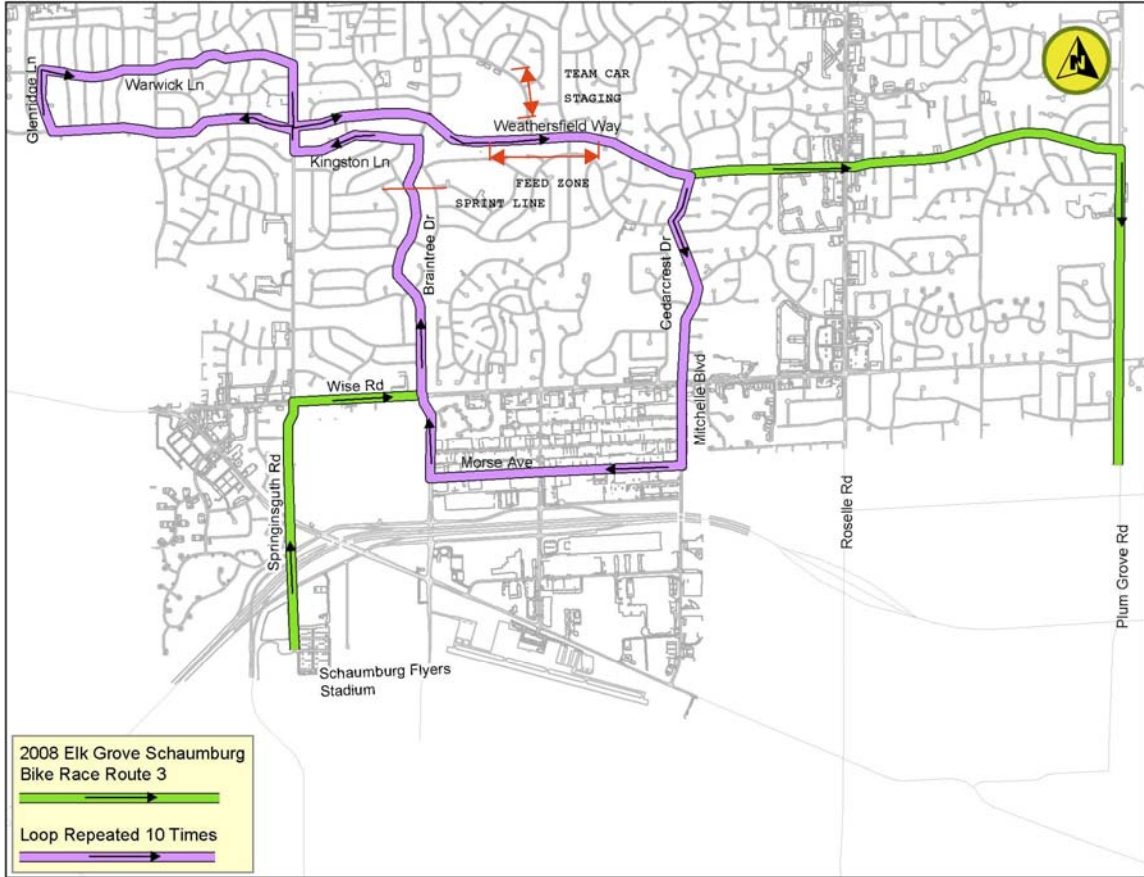
Road Race COURSE (170K)

Rider sign-in will be located in the west parking lot of the Schaumburg Flyers Baseball Stadium at the Start/Finish line. Sign-in will open at 2:15pm and closes at 3:00pm. Riders must be at sign-in and be available for staging and introductions by 3:15pm. The Start line will be located at the entrance to the west parking lot of the Schaumburg Flyers Baseball Stadium. The finish line is located adjacent to the Hattendorf Center parking lot (225 Elk Grove Blvd.). Riders outside a 5% finishing time will not be able to start the next stage.

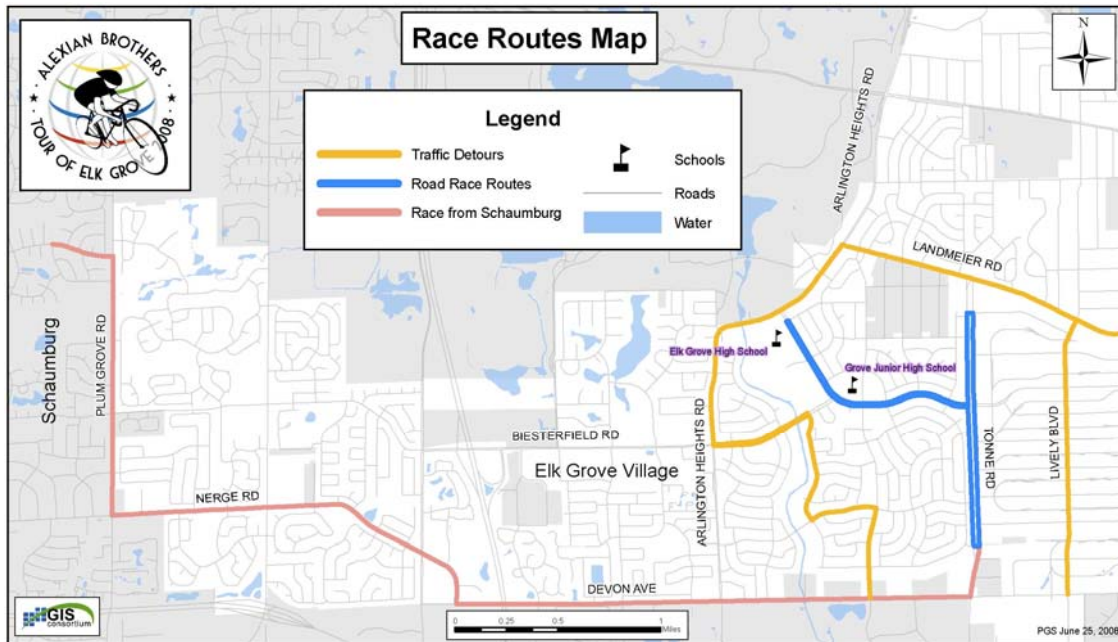
STAGE 2 – COURSE DESCRIPTION

The event is a 170km road stage. The course is on residential and business streets of Schaumburg and Elk Grove Village. Please be aware and courteous of public and private property. The caravan will follow the riders after the start of the race and turn out at Braintree to a designated staging area. Feeding will be allowed from 50 km to 20 km to go. The feed zone will be located near the intersection of Weathersfield Way and Braintree.

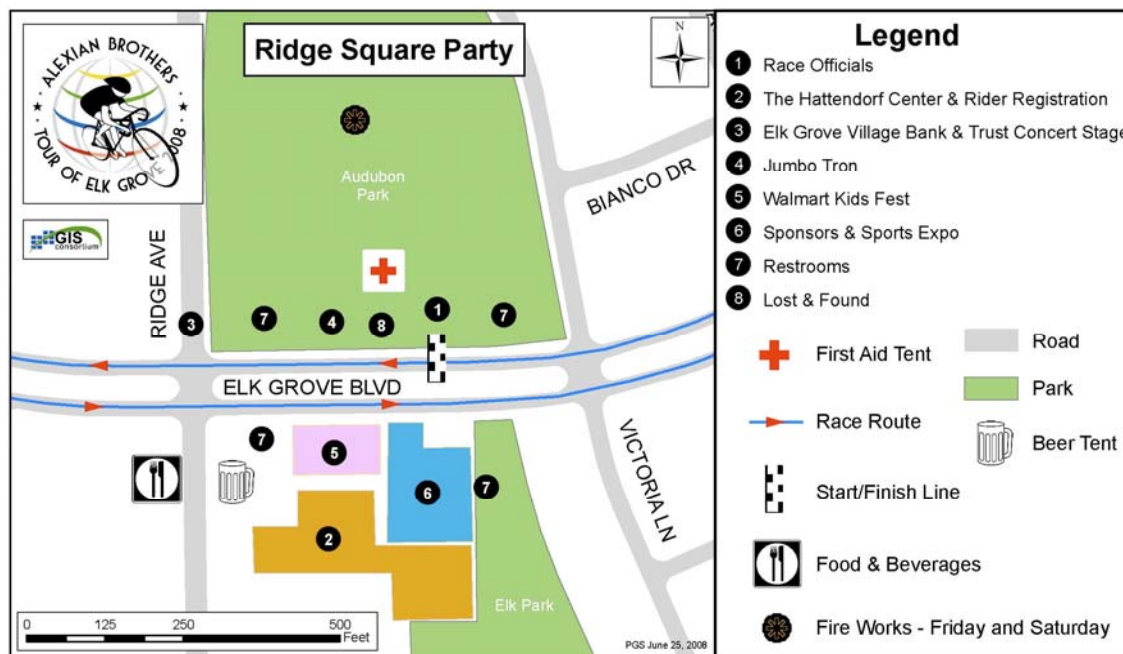




Transition Map

STAGE 2- CARAVAN PROCEDURES

- Safety is most important in any situation
- Team vehicles may only be driven by licensed team managers
- Event staff will be directing the caravan to parking areas. The parking area is located at: in Schaumburg see map above, in Elk Grove at Love Street
- Caravan parking and procedures will be reviewed at the mandatory manager's meeting
- All vehicles must be staged at the start line no later than 30 minutes prior to race start. Drivers must remain near their vehicles.
- The race commissaries are in charge of the race and the race caravan, follow their instructions. Speeding and reckless driving during the transition will result in citations and ejection from the event. The Tour of Elk Grove is held on public roads.
- The left lane is reserved for passage of vehicles performing technical support. All other vehicles must remain in single file in the right lane. In any case, all vehicles must yield to vehicles moving up for technical support during the transition stage of the event.
- Vehicles wishing to drop back shall pull to the far right hand side of the road and allow the caravan vehicles to pass on the left until their position is reached

STAGE 2 – TIME BONUSES

Stage 2 top three finishers will receive the following time bonus:

1. First place finisher receives a 20 second time second bonus
2. Second place finisher receive a 12 second bonus
3. Third place finisher receives an 8 second bonus

STAGE 2 – SPRINT TIME BONUSES

Stage 2 sprint winners will receive the following time bonus:

1. First place finisher receives a 6 second time bonus
2. Second place finisher receives a 4 second time bonus
3. Third place finisher receives a 2 second time bonus

STAGE 2 – HALF RACE AWARD

The rider leading the race at the conclusion of 85 Km will be recognized as the “half race” winner. The winner of the half race sprint **MUST complete the entire race in order to qualify for the prize**. If the initial rider fails to finish the race, then the award passes on to the next placed rider who completes the event.

STAGE 2 – SPRINT CHALLENGE

This will be a prize based upon point accumulation. Sprint points will be awarded at the designated line on the course in Schaumburg and then at the finish line in Elk Grove. Points will be awarded to the first 5 racers to cross the line and will be awarded at 133 Km, 109 Km and 78 Km. Points are: 7, 5, 3, 2, and 1: Awards comprise of the top 3 sprint finishers with the most accumulated points and will be awarded the following amounts:

- 1st Place Sprint Finisher \$3,000
- 2nd Place Sprint Finisher \$1,550
- 3rd Place Sprint Finisher \$450

If there is a tie in the placing by points, the tie will be broken by final placing at the end of the race in favor of the higher placing rider. Riders must finish the race in order to keep their points and place in the final overall standings for the Challenge. If the rider does not finish the race, the next rider in order with total points and finishes will receive the award.

STAGE 3 at 3:00 p.m. Sunday, August 3rd

1.7 MILE CRITERIUM COURSE (110K – 40 LAPS)

The course is a 110 Km, (40 Laps) of a 1.7 mile circuit with four turns, and a long straightaway to the finish line. The course is on residential and business streets of Elk Grove Village. Please be aware and courteous of public and private property. The start and finish line is located adjacent to the Hattendorf Center parking lot (225 Elk Grove Blvd.). The Chief Referee will determine if feeding will be allowed. If allowed, the feed zone will be located after the first turn between Crest and Love St.

STAGE 3 – TIME BONUSES

Stage 3 top three finishers will receive the following time bonus:

1. First place finisher receives a 20 second bonus
2. Second place finisher receive a 12 second bonus
3. Third place finisher receives an 8 second bonus

STAGE 3 – SPRINT TIME BONUSES

Stage - 3 sprint winners will receive the following time bonus:

1. First place finisher receives a 6 second time bonus
2. Second place finisher receives a 4 second time bonus
3. Third place finisher receives a 2 second time bonus

STAGE 3 – HALF RACE AWARD

The rider leading the race at the conclusion of lap 20 and leading into the beginning of lap 19 to go will be recognized as the “half race” winner. The winner of the half race sprint **MUST complete the entire race in order to qualify for the prize**. If the initial rider fails to finish the race, then the award passes on to the next placed rider who completes the event.

STAGE 3 – SPRINT CHALLENGE

This will be a prize based upon point accumulation. Sprint points will be awarded at the Start/ Finish line. Points will be awarded to the first 5 racers to cross the line and will be awarded at lap 30, 25 and 15 only. Points are: 7, 5, 3, 2, and 1: Awards comprise of the top 3 sprint finishers with the most accumulated points and will be awarded the following amounts:

- 1st Place Sprint Finisher \$3,000
- 2nd Place Sprint Finisher \$1,550
- 3rd Place Sprint Finisher \$450

If there is a tie in the placing by points, the tie will be broken by final placing at the end of the race in favor of the higher placing rider. Riders must finish the race in order to keep their points and place in the final overall standings for the Challenge. If the rider does not finish the race, the next rider in order with total points and finishes will receive the award.

STAGE 3 – PRIME LAPS

The following primes will be designated on the laps listed:

1. \$100 Prime for the second Lap of the race
2. \$100 Prime for Lap 4
3. \$500 Prime for Lap 6
4. \$100 Prime for Lap 9
5. \$200 Prime for Lap 12
6. \$100 Prime for Lap 17
7. \$800 Prime for Lap 23
8. \$1,000 Prime for Lap 27
9. \$400 Prime for Lap 32
10. \$100 Prime for Lap 34
11. \$100 Prime for lap 36
12. \$300 Prime for Lap 38

RIDERS OUT OF CONTENTION / LAPPED

Riders out of contention or in danger of being lapped will be asked to withdraw by the Commissaries. Riders refusing to withdraw will be disqualified and fined per the regulations.

REPAIR PITS / FREE LAPS

There will be one repair pit at the intersection of Elk Grove Blvd and Love St., where all free laps and mechanical repairs must be taken. This pit allows access from two sides of the course. Riders must report to the official at the neutral pit in order to obtain their free lap. Free laps are allowed until 5 laps to go. Riders eligible for mid-Race or Sprint Challenge awards that are withdrawn under these conditions shall be deemed to have finished the race, maintaining their standings to that point.

Section 3

AWARDS DISTRIBUTION

Upon completing a race the athlete should present his/herself at the “Awards Distribution Area”. After presenting a photo ID, the rider will need to fill out a payment form and provide necessary information for tax purposes which include social security numbers or FEIN numbers if operating as a team/business. Team/businesses will need to fill out a W-9 form in accordance with the federal guidelines tax code before given final payment distribution. All forms if not filled out on site must be filled out and mailed back to Special Events Management, 2221 W. 43rd St, Chicago, IL 60609 in order to receive prize money.
